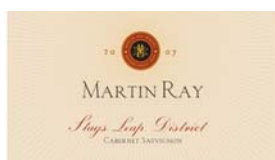


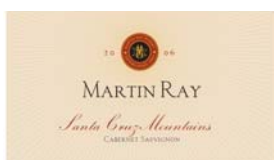

NOTES**

A rich, dark ruby color leads you to a soft entry of the ripe fruit forward structure of this wine. Abundant aromas of plum and black currant will seduce and satisfy your palate. Smooth, creamy oak flavors.



A distinctive wine beautiful balance and solid structure. Inviting, elegant aromas of vanilla and cherry lead to lush flavors of blackberry and plum, finishing with a lingering whisper of toasty oak.



A tightly wound wine with a rich, concentrated structure. Enticing aromas and flavors of sumptuous cherries, black currants and ripe plums are accented by hints of vanilla oak.



This hearty, bold Cabernet is rich with aromas of black cherries and plum with overtones of vanilla. Layers of elegant, dark fruits are rich and give the wine great depth.

Martin Ray Winery was established in 1943 in the Santa Cruz Mountains. Martin

### VINEYARDS

### WINEMAKING

Head winemaker, Bill Batchelor, is no stranger to Sonoma County and has made wine for over twenty years.

Bill's intuitive approach to wine-making create the perfect conditions where wines develop naturally. Ray believed that great wine developed on its own without the interference of the winemaker. In fact, great winemaking is the result of the winemaker's ability to use those tools that Mother Nature provides. We use the finest French oak barrels with a preference for medium toast to allow the

perfect integration of all the key components that go into making great wine.

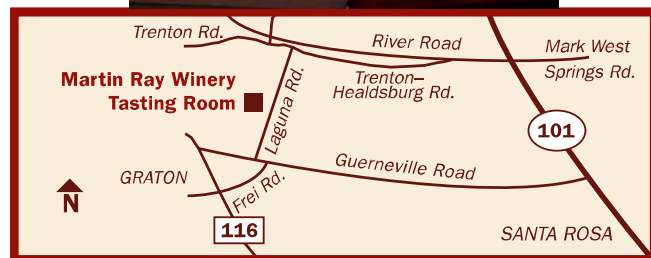
### TASTING ROOM
